Section 2.1

The following text from the fourth paragraph has been removed

Consider, for example, the process $X_t = \sin(\omega t + U)$, where U is uniformly distributed on $[0, 2\pi]$: it is weakly stationary, but its values for all t are completely determined by X_0 .
