Subject CA2 — Modelling Module Syllabus

Aim

The aim of this module is to ensure that the successful candidate understands how to model data in practice, maintain an audit trail for information and communicate the results.

Links to other subjects

Subject CA2 — Modelling: requires the student to undertake a practical modelling assignment. This can be based on any of the Core Technical subjects CT1–CT8 and also uses the principles in Subject CA1 — Core Applications Concepts and the communications development in Subject CA3 — Communications.

Previous related study

A student can apply to work through the module when they and their employer decide.

However, it is strongly recommended that the student has seriously attempted CT1-CT8 (gaining a pass, FA or FB) and has at least one year's work experience.

The student needs a working knowledge of computer based spreadsheets and word processing packages.

Objectives

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate:

- analysis and summary of data
- development of a model with audit trail
- ability to apply results
- interpretation of results
- communication of results and conclusions to a technical audience
