## Member Interest Groups

## What is a Member Interest Group?

A Member Interest Group is a group of members of the Actuarial Profession who share an area of interest, such as:

- a practice area
- a hot topic
- a geographical link.

A Member Interest Group should also protect the Profession's reputation and act in the interests of the Profession.

All members of the Profession are welcome to join or set up a Member Interest Group.



## What do Member Interest Groups do?

A Member Interest Group can determine its own organisation and activities. This could include:

- organising events
- organising social or professional networking opportunities
- holding online discussions
- developing research papers to stimulate debates
- producing newsletters.

## Why should I join a Member Interest Group?

Being part of a Member Interest Group will give you an opportunity to:

- network with people who share your interests
- share knowledge and experience
- influence the Profession's policy
- mentor and support others in the Profession
- contribute ideas to support the Profession's development.
