Abstract and Paper Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts should be submitted by **Friday 20 February 2009** to a.s.macdonald@ma.hw.ac.uk.
- Papers should be submitted in the final form by **Friday 31 August 2009** to claire.marsh@actuaries.org.uk.
- All abstracts and papers should be submitted electronically in PDF format.
- Abstracts should be between 300 and 500 words in length.
- Papers should be no more than 10,000 words in length.
- Accepted papers will appear on the Joining Forces on Mortality and Longevity, website in a downloadable format approximately three weeks before the conference.
- The first page of the paper should only contain the proposed title for the paper, the full names, first name and surname, postal addresses and email addresses of all authors and a telephone number for at least one contact author. Please indicate clearly if the contact author is not the lead author. The main text should start on page 2.
- If possible papers should include a “running heading” on each page: that is, the title (or a shortened version) at the top of each page.
- Pages within the paper should be numbered.
