

CA2 Module: Assessment criteria

The following criteria will be used to assess the students' performances in the CA2 Module:

The pass criterion is that the audit trail and summary give, overall, a reasonable overview of the model and the results which could be followed by a senior colleague and could be corrected and worked on by a fellow student.

The students will prepare:

- 1 Model with documentation, including an audit trail
- 2 Summary

The spreadsheet should cover the model and include an audit trail:

• Audit approach	20
• Audit content	25
• Use of appropriate techniques	10
Total	55 marks

The summary should cover the following:

• Description/Approach	10
• Results, appropriate answers	10
• Conclusions	15
With up to 5 marks for Drafting	5
Total	40 marks

Total marks awarded for model 95 marks

The figures at the side indicate the weight of marks for each aspect.

In addition, up to 5 marks will be given for the student's ability to work independently.

The summary will be evaluated based on content of results and conclusions and only 5 marks will be given for drafting aspects. There must be clear links between the spreadsheet and the summary. Students should aim for around 5 pages of summary comments, using bullet points and charts or other visual aids. Students may choose to use a few more pages if they believe this enhances clarity of communication.
