

CITY CHURCHES GUIDED WALK AND SUPPER
THURSDAY 12TH JUNE 2008

Continuing with our programme of events open to all members of the profession, the Worshipful Company of Actuaries is delighted to announce details of a guided evening walk on the theme of City churches. The City contains many hidden treasures and its beautiful churches are a splendid example of these. Following the Great Fire of London in 1666, a large number of City churches had to be rebuilt and there are some wonderful examples of Sir Christopher Wren's work, including the most famous of all, St Paul's Cathedral. We will visit a number of other Wren churches on our walk, as well as some of the very few original churches that escaped damage in the Great Fire. Each church has its own unique and fascinating history.

We will meet under Temple Bar (at Paternoster Square, near to the entrance to St Paul's Cathedral) at **6pm prompt for a 6.15pm** start. We will divide into two groups. The first group will be led by actuary Peter Tompkins, a City Guide and Past Chairman of the Society of Young Freemen. The second group will be led by Past Master Robin Michaelson, also a City Guide. Both guides will be leading the walks at no charge, however all attendees are being asked to give a donation of £10 a head (plus Gift Aid) to be divided between the Lord Mayor's Appeal and the City Heritage Exhibition.

The two groups will meet up at the end of the walk at about 7.45pm when we shall retire to a nearby wine bar (City Pipe, Foster Lane, EC2V 6HD) for refreshments and an opportunity to socialise. The Worshipful Company of Actuaries has extended an invitation to all members of the profession and their partners and to members of the Society of Young Freemen to join us for the evening. Please come along and make some new friends.

The cost of the evening will be **£25** per person. This includes a donation of £10 to be divided between the Lord Mayor's Appeal and the City Heritage Exhibition and a substantial finger buffet at the end of the walk.
