

# New Standard Mortality Tables The “00” Series

**Half-day seminar

The Continuous Mortality Investigation Bureau (CMIB) intends to produce new standard tables of mortality based on the 1999-2002 experience, to be designated the “00” Series, together with a methodology for projecting future mortality.

As part of the process of this work, the CMIB is preparing two discussion documents that cover graduation and projection issues respectively. The CMIB is very keen to receive feedback on the proposed graduations and projections, and so is pleased to announce that a seminar has been organised for this purpose.

The seminar will be based around Working Papers 8 (graduations) and 3 (projections). Working Paper 3 was published in March 2004, Working Paper 8 will be published in May 2004. CMIB working papers can be downloaded from:
