

## CA2 Model documentation, analysis and reporting

### Information for non-UK based students

#### When you must take the CA2 Model documentation, analysis and reporting practical exam

To take this practical exam you must have passed or been exempted by the Actuarial Profession from all the CT subjects or their earlier equivalents.

Better candidates are those who have experience of communicating technical material to peer and senior colleagues. Hence, students may wish to wait until they have tackled CA3 or CA1 before taking this module.

#### Where you must attend the two-day course

You are expected to attend the two-day practical exam in the UK or in the country where you work if an exam is available in that country. Some local actuarial associations are offering these exams.

If you complete the practical exam by attending an exam run by an actuarial association outside the UK you will usually need to apply to the Actuarial Profession for an exemption from CA2. A fee will be charged for this, the amount being the same as for other CA subjects.

Countries where exams are being run by the Actuarial Profession, and no exemption fee is payable:

- Ireland

Countries where courses are being run by local associations, and an exemption fee is payable:

- India
- Malaysia
- South Africa
- Singapore

Other venues proposed include: China; Australia/New Zealand (subject to demand)
