- ➤ Old scheme
 - Only compulsory for statutory actuaries
- ➤ New scheme effective July 2006
 - All actuaries must comply (UK and non-UK)
 - Flexible design own programme to meet own needs
 - Record keeping on website
 - 3 categories of skill
 - New CPD Handbook see website

Category 1 – requiring practising certificates Category 2 – working in area covered by SA syllabus Category 3 – working outside Categories 1, 2 Category 4 – not working CPD – Category 1 Requiring practising certificate 15 hours "verifiable" CPD 10 hours must be relevant to practising certificate area of work 5 hours must be external to employer 2 hours on developing professional skills – eg

CPD - Category 2

every 10 years

Working in area covered by SA syllabus

non-actuarial technical skills, professional ethics – must attend professionalism event

As for Category 1 except:

- "personally assessed activities" acceptable instead of "verifiable" ones
- Some activities to be external to employer
