The Mortality Research Steering Committee (MRSC) is a group of actuaries and professionals from related disciplines who aim to advance mortality research. The committee is seeking to recruit new members from the actuarial community or related disciplines.

### **Task and Person Specification**

## **Task Specification**

The committee member will be required to:

- Help ensure IFoA mortality, morbidity and longevity research aligns with the IFoA strategic objectives
- Identify opportunities for collaboration with the wider community of academics, actuarial bodies and other professional associations.
- Maintain awareness of current research, emerging issues and hot topics in mortality, morbidity and longevity research and communicate these to the committee members.
- Assist with the oversight of knowledge exchange activities such as the publication of the IFoA's 'Longevity Bulletin'.

#### **Tenure**

This appointment is for a three year period.

#### Time commitment

The expected time commitment for this role is an average of 1–3 hours per month dependent upon activities undertaken.

### **Person Specification**

Candidates will ideally have the following skills and experience:

- He/she is a member of the IFoA with considerable experience in this area, or is an academic with a track record of publication in relevant areas.
- He/she has an understanding of the research strategy of the IFoA and a desire to help shape and develop the future research agenda of the actuarial profession.
- He/she has expert actuarial subject knowledge and a strong interest in mortality, morbidity and longevity or a related discipline such as demography, epidemiology gerontology, etc.
- He/she has a good industry or academic profile and a network of contacts in the mortality, morbidity and longevity field and/or related disciplines.
- He/she has experience of producing and reviewing research outputs such as conference papers and research reports.

### In return, the volunteer will:

- Help to shape the future of demography, epidemiology, gerontology, longevity and mortality research.
- Be able to influence and contribute to this area at a policy level.
- Be provided with excellent professional support and assistance during their tenure on the committee.
- Develop their network of contacts across industry and academia.
