NOTES ON THE FINANCIAL TIMES-ACTUARIES EQUITY SHARE INDICES IN 1983

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1. Classification of Stock Exchange Securities by Industry

The original classifications were set out in the 1970 note in this series (T.F.A., 32, pp. 433-436). Subsequent amendments were set out in the notes for 1971-74, 1977 and 1979-80 (T.F.A., 33, 112; 33, 295; 34, 127; 34, 455; 36, 69; 37, 70 and 37, 315). Minor amendments were made to three category definitions during 1983.

During the year it was decided that the existing category 19 (Electricals—excluding Radio & TV) should be subdivided in order to distinguish the proliferating electronic companies. As a result two new categories were adopted at the year-end:—

35 Electronics

44 Security & Alarm Services

and also minor changes were made to the titles of three categories—which became:—

19 Electricals

69 Office Equipment (excluding Computers)

76 Miscellaneous—Unclassified

As a result of the quarterly meetings of the Classification Sub-Committee of the Joint Investment and Index Committee, the classifications of 109 companies were changed, following changes in their business or, (in the majority of cases) the subdivision referred to in the previous paragraph. These changes were only made after notification to the company concerned and usually after discussion; a further 83 companies, in addition to those with whom discussions had begun in earlier years, were first approached in 1983.

The Stock Exchange continued to classify the new companies either granted a full quotation, or quoted on the Unlisted Securities Market.

2. Constituent Changes in the Equity Indices

During 1983 forty-five constituents were removed from the indices—five more than in 1982. As shown in Table A, 24 of these constituents were acquired by other companies, 1 went into liquidation, 1 changed its tax residence to Hong Kong, 3 investment trusts were unitized and the other 16 were removed under the casualty rule due to their persisting small capitalisations.

The forty-five new constituents replacing those removed are set out in Table B. It was incidentally agreed that during 1984 it might not necessarily be appropriate to replace a constituent removed outside the 500 share index—with the result that the number of constituents in the All-Share Index would fall below 750.

Forty-three of the companies reclassified during the year—as described in s. 1—were constituents, and consequently their index classifications were changed as set out in Table C. Most of the changes were in the Electrical subsection, which was subdivided into two (04—Electricals and 05—Electronics) in much the same way as was the corresponding Stock Exchange classification category—see the previous section. In order to achieve this, however, it was necessary to discontinue the existing 05—Engineering Contractors subsection, the capitalisation of which was shrinking to about \$\frac{1}{2}\%\$ of the All-Share Index. As a result those constituents in the following Stock Exchange categories had to be moved to new index subsections:

The fourteen constituents which changed their names are shown in Table D.

In 1983 the total number of capital changes (not just those involving changes of constituent) recorded rose to 574—rather more than in most recent years, even without allowing for the greater than usual number of reclassifications.

3. Miscellaneous

The equity share index values, yields and ratios at the end of 1983 (prior to the changes) are set out in Table E.

In respect of those fifteen groups or subsections effected by the year-end constituent changes, certain of the altered details (after the changes) appear for the end of 1983 in Table F.

Early in 1984 the Stock Exchange began to publish a new index of the "top 100" companies calculated on a real-time basis and updated every minute. The base is 1000-0 at the close of business on 30 December 1983 and the new index is to be known as the F.T.S.E. 100 Index. It is intended by both the Stock Exchange's own Traded Option Market and also the London International Financial Futures Exchange to write contracts on the new index.

The new index is not the responsibility of actuaries but both the Institute and Faculty are represented on its Steering Committee, and in fact five out of its dozen members are also on our Joint Investment and Index Committee.


