# THE RECENT TREND OF MORTALITY IN ENGLAND AND WALES 

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In continuation of the tables given on pp. 99-100, the central death rates in age groups for males and females separately in the year 1939 are shown in Table r , and the ratios of these death rates to the corresponding rates for the years $1930-31-32$ are shown in Table 2. In the case of males, both the deaths and the populations from which the death rates have been derived are limited to civilians.
