# REVIEW OF THE RECENT TREND OF MORTALITY IN ENGLAND AND WALES 

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In continuation of the tables given in $\mathfrak{7}$.I.A. Vol. LxvirI, pp. 52I-5, the central death-rates in age groups for males and females separately in the year 1937 are shown in Table 1, and the ratios of these death-rates to the corresponding rates for the years 1930-32 are shown in Table 2.
