NATIONAL INSURANCE (INDUSTRIAL INJURIES)

Employers' Liability Insurance (Modification) Order, 1948

An extract from an Order made in pursuance of subsection (3) of section 89 of the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act, 1946 (9 and 10 Geo. 6, c. 62)

- 1. In the case of an assurance company which carries on employers' liability insurance business and any other class of assurance business to which the Assurance Companies Acts, 1909 to 1946 (hereinafter called 'the Acts'), apply the employers' liability insurance business need not, in respect of any financial year of the company commencing after the 30th November, 1947, be treated as a class of business to which the Acts apply, and the said company shall not, in relation to that business be bound by the provisions of the Acts.
- 2. Save as hereinafter provided nothing in the foregoing paragraph shall be taken to exempt from any of the provisions of the Acts an assurance company which carries on employers' liability insurance business and no other assurance business to which the Acts apply; but such an assurance company need not prepare annually a statement of its employers' liability insurance business in the form set forth in the Fourth Schedule to the Assurance Companies Act, 1909, and applicable to employers' liability insurance business, as required by subsection 1 (c) of sections 33 of that Act.
- 3. In this Order the expressions 'assurance company' and 'employers' liability insurance business' have the same meanings as in the Assurance Companies Act, 1909.
 - 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 6th day of August, 1948.
- 5. This Order may be cited as the Employers' Liability Insurance (Modification) Order, 1948.
