Terms of Reference

Purpose

LLB has established this Task & Finish Group (T&FG) to provide the Board with strategic insight into the future of the IFoA's qualifications framework and Lifelong Learning so that:

- Our qualifications framework and Lifelong Learning remain fit for purpose
- They 'speak' to the contemporary actuarial marketplace
- Where possible the IFoA can achieve appropriate economies of scale by integrating pre-qualification education and Lifelong Learning

The T&FG is specifically tasked with considering and making recommendations to the Board on:

- The structural enablers required in the pre-qualification educational framework to allow agile introduction of new subject domains
- The potential for sharing such new domains within the IFoA's Lifelong Learning offering
- What potential new subject domains the IFoA should be considering
- The scope for partnering with other stakeholders in development of these new domains
- The implications of such changes for positioning of the IFoA Associateship and Fellowship
- How to ensure any proposed changes comply with competition and discrimination legislation, and other regulations such as advertising standards

- A background understanding of the IFoA's professional actuarial learning and its aspirations for Lifelong Learning
- Awareness of the global requirements for actuarial learning
- A strategic mind set and views on how the profession's learning can support current and future members and enhance their standing globally
- Sound commercial acumen
- A willingness to play a proactive role in championing the education and learning activities of the IFoA

Desirable

- Experience of corporate training and development of workforces
- An understanding of not-for-profit public interest bodies with global memberships
- An appreciation of the challenges facing professions in a global environment

Term

It is expected that the T&FG will deliver initial outcomes within 6 months.
