Majority View Score

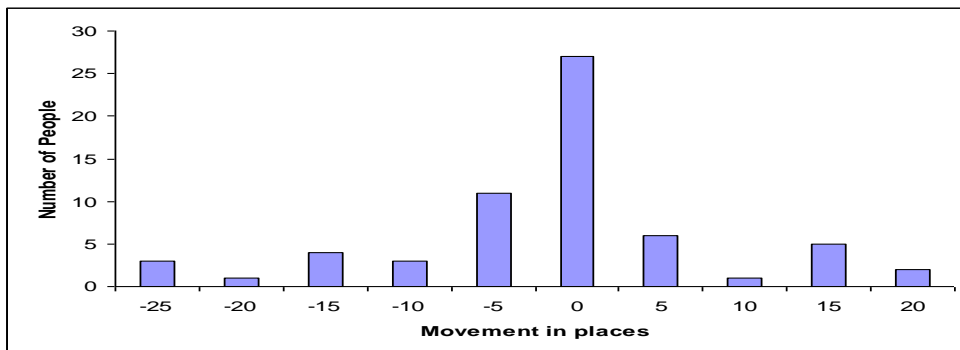
Year 1 = 50 Points
